The grapes are sourced from the Wairau valley which probably produces the best fruit in Marlborough. The fruit is picked in the cool of the morning and processed using anaerobic techniques to retain the fruit characteristics. Unoaked too.

9 **Saint-Véran 2006 Domaine de la Croix Senaillet** France Burgundy £144.00 12 x 75cl £12.00

Richard and Stéphane run this 22 hectare domaine based at Davayé in the heart of the Saint Véran appellation. All their wines are fermented and aged in stainless steel to preserve the maximum of freshness and aroma.
