Vin de Pays d'Oc, France
A classic example of this much loved grape
- 2. Rocco Bay White 2009** **£5.95**
Western Cape, South Africa
A Chenin Blanc/ Sauvignon Blanc blend that offers up a touch of orchard fruits.
- 3. Les Templiers Chardonnay 2008** **£6.75**
Vin de Pays Cotes de Thongue, France
A delicious unoaked Chardonnay the is a great all-rounder.

Rosé

- 4. Terre d'Azur Syrah Rosé 2009** **£6.50**
Vin de Pays d'Oc
Rosé is not just for Summer! This hints of summer fruits with a refreshingly dry finish.

One of the top producers in Penedès and superb value for money.
- 8. Prosecco di Valdobbiadene Brut 2008** **£12**
Col de' Salici, Italy
Prosecco is uber-fashionable these days and this is a very refreshing, fruity example of classic Italian bubbly. Check out our classic Bellini cocktail recipe on the web!
- 9. Crémant de Loire NV, Brut** **£12.50**
Langlois-Château, Saumur, France
Saumur in the Loire Valley produces the finest sparkling wines in France outside of Champagne. This is one of the best and made by the same process as Champagne.
- 10. Crémant de Loire Rosé NV, Brut** **£13.00**
Langlois-Château, Saumur, France
This is actually made as a Rosé before the secondary fermentation takes place in bottle. Saumur is a great source of Sparkling wine outside of Champagne.
- 11. Breaky Bottom 2006** **£22.00**
East Sussex
A stunning location in the Sussex Downs and Peter Hall, the owner, manages to prize out an exceptional sparkling wine from the Sylvaner grape.

- 12. Ayla NV, Brut Majeur** **£24.00**
£22 if you order a case of 6 bottles or more. This artisan Champagne house sources its grapes mainly from Grand Cru and 1er Cru vineyards, which accounts for the exceptional quality at this price point.
- 13. Bollinger NV, Special Cuvée** **£35.00**
£30 per bottle if you order a case of 6 or more. Order 2 cases or more and receive 6 complimentary Bollinger Flutes! (Subject to availability). Now the official Champagne for 007, this famous family-owned producer continues to add to their collection of accolades.
- 14. Ayala Blanc de Blancs 2004** **£45.00**
This is a blend of Chardonnay grapes from three Grand Cru vineyards from the Côtes des Blancs. This is an exceptionally elegant, creamy style and a treat to drink on its own or with a creamy risotto.

- 15. Gewurztraminer Signature 2008** **£12.50**
René Muré
The perfect wine for Christmas – full of spice, not to mention an ideal wine for spicy food.

Bordeaux

- 16. Château Terrefort Lescale 2007** **£8.75**
Bordeaux Rouge
Our “house” Claret and always dependable
- 17. Château d’Agassac 2005** **£18.00**
Cru Bourgeois Haut Médoc
For something more stylish, this excellent property offers the ideal Christmas Day classic.

Burgundy

White

- 18. Bourgogne Blanc 2008** **£11.50**
Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard
Produced from vines just outside the Chablis region, but very “Chablis” like in style. Try this with the Seabass and herby mayonnaise recipe on our web-site – delicious!
- 19. Chablis 2008** **£14.25**
Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard
Jean-Marc Brocard was one of the early champions of Organic viticulture and the exceptional quality of his grapes, produces some of the best wines of the region.

Red

- 20. Bourgogne Hautes Côtes de Nuits 2009** **£11.50**
Caves des Hautes Côtes
Great quality Pinot Noir from an exceptional vintage – soft, ripe red berry fruit and silky tannins.
- 21. Givry 2008** **£19.50**
Domaine de la Ferté
This appellation within the Côtes Chalonnaise is a great source of fine burgundy and Dom de La Ferté is one of the best estates. Touches of gamey notes on the nose and very sensual on the palate.

Loire Valley

White

- 22. Saumur Blanc 2009** **£9.75**

Domaine Langlois-Château

100% Chenin Blanc, producing a racy, lemony, dry white.

- 23. Sancerre 2008** **£15.00**

Château de Fontaine-Audon

This famous estate is located on the classic flinty soils that characterise the wines from Sancerre. Lovely aromatic Sauvignon nose with nuances of tropical fruit and pithy grapefruit. Great with goats cheese or fish.

Rosé

- 24. Cabernet de Saumur Rosé 2009** **£9.75**

Domaine Langlois-Château

With just a couple of hours contact with the Cabernet Franc grapes you have a subtle salmon-pink colour and the delicate berry fruit aromas and flavours. Ideal with spicy dishes and cheeses.

Red

- 25. Château de Varrains 2003** **£13.50**

Saumur Rouge, Domaine Langlois-Château

Very aromatic, toasty aroma, mixed with ripe red fruits. Medium-full-bodied, with hints of chocolate and roasted coffee beans.

Rhone Valley

- 26. Crozes Hermitage 2007** **£14.50**

Jeannine Boutin

Exuberant super ripe fruit brings the wine complex aromas of lavender and liquorice and an almost sweet berry like character, with a hint of dark chocolate.

- 27. St Joseph 2007 Parcelle de Jean** **£16.00**

Jeannine Boutin

This juicy red has all the hallmarks of a Northern Rhone - lavender and black pepper notes on the nose; dark berry fruits mixed with an almost meaty-savoury flavour

- 28. Gigondas Côtes Jugundas 2006** **£16.00**

La Ferme du Mont

Packed with ripe berry fruits, herbs, roasted peppers and spice. Give this a good hour to breathe

- 29. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Cotes Capelan 2007** **£30.00**

La Ferme du Mont

One of the finest Châteauneufs in this remarkable vintage.

Italy

White

- 30. Orvieto Classico 2008, Umbria** **£8.75**
Campogrande, Antinori
Classic Orvieto – almond and floral notes with melon fruit and refreshingly tangy palate. Perfect with butternut risotto.
- 31. Vermentino di Bolgheri 2008, Tuscany** **£15.00**
Guado al Tasso
This shows the combination of crispness and breadth that marks Vermentino, with engaging citrus flavours and a long mineral finish.

Red

- 32. Modello Rosso delle Venezie 2008, Veneto** **£8.75**
Masi
Perfect for lazy nights in with a bowl of pasta – soft, plump, medium bodied easy drinking.
- 33. Bonacosta Valpolicella 2008, Veneto** **£10.25**
Masi
This is what Valpolicella should be about – classic cherry notes throughout.
- 34. Dolcetto d’Alba 2008** **£11.75**
Prunotto
Packed with ripe, crushed red berry fruit flavours.
- 35. Campofiorin 2007** **£12.50**
Masi
A mini-Amarone that is unique to Masi and their signature wine. Not as powerful as an Amarone, but displays many of the rich, spicy and dark fruit character of its more famous cousin.

Spain

- 36. La Horra 2008, Ribera del Duero** **£20**
Bodegas La Horra
From 20 year old Tempranillo vines and has rich bright and abundant elegance. Produced by the same team behind Bodegas Roda, one of the finest estates in Rioja.

New World

Argentina

White

- 37. Urban Torrontes 2009, Bodegas Fournier** **£7.50**
Uco Valley, Mendoza
Rapidly becoming the signature white grape of Argentina. Reminiscent to a Gewurztraminer from Alsace.

Red

- 38. Urban Malbec 2009, Bodegas Fournier** **£8.00**
Uco Valley, Mendoza
Consistently one of the best Malbec's we have come across at this price. Full bodied and richly endowed.

Chile

White

- 39. Casa Lapostolle Semillon 2007** **£7.50**
Rapel Valley
This was a winner with our fresh salmon salad recipe. See details on the website.

Red

- 40. De Martino Estate Merlot 2008** **£7.50**
Maipo Valley
Best Chilean Producer of the year 2009, IWSC
- 41. Equus Carmenère 2008** **£8.25**
Maipo Valley
Smooth and supple with good concentration of blackberries and balance.

New Zealand

- 42. The Crossings Pinot Noir 2009** **£10**
Awatere Valley
The palate is rich and unusually mouth filling for an Awatere wine while retaining the taut structure and minerality that typifies the sub region's fruit.

South Africa

White

- 43. Chenin Blanc 2009, Stellenbosch** **£7.50**
Kaapzicht Estate
Really fresh and crisp with delicious pineapple fruit balanced by tangy, citrus flavours. Try this with our grilled prawn and atichoke salad on the web-site!
- 44. Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2009** **£10**
Klein Constantia, Constantia
Ripe tropical aromas of pineapple and passionfruit come to the fore, whilst the palate exhibits Sauvignon Blanc characteristics of pithy grapefruit zest and tight, mineral acidity.
- 45. Crocodile's Lair Chardonnay 2009, Walkers Bay** **£12.50**
Bouchard Finlayson
The relatively cool climate at this etate in Walker Bay produces wines with a strong Burgundian reference.

- 46. Kaapzicht Estate Red 2007 (Cabernet/Cinsault)** **£9.00**
Stellenbosch
Big, juicy and certain to keep away the winter chills.
- 47. Pinotage 2007, Stellenbosch** **£12**
Kaapzicht Estate
Kaapzicht are one of the top producers of South Africa's signature red grape and this is a great match with big, hearty dishes.
- 48. Marlbrook Red 2007** **£15.50**
Klein Constantia, Constantia
Carefully selected parcels of Klein Constantia's healthiest grapes are used to make this Bordeaux-style blend.

Fortified Wines

Sherry

- 49. Manzanilla La Gitana** **£9.00**
Bodegas Hidalgo
One of the best aperitifs. Best served chilled in a wine glass. Ideal as an accompaniment to tapas, sea food, fish, hams, mild cheeses and nuts.
- 50. Pedro Ximénez Triana** **£15.00**
Bodegas Hidalgo
Serve slightly chilled. Pedro Ximenez of this quality can either be served on its own as a luxurious after-dinner drink, or as a dessert wine. Try with chocolate puddings, at Christmas or even poured over rum and raisin ice cream!

Madeira

- 51. 5 Year Old Finest Medium Dry** **£10 per**
Henriques & Henriques **50cl bottle**
Ideal served as an aperitif, chilled or with seafood and smoked fish. Madeira should be cellared upright.
- 52. 10 Year Old Malmsey** **£17 per**
Henriques & Henriques **50cl bottle**
It is intense with complex flavours of walnut, dried fruits, coffee and caramel. This is a full-bodied wine with background acidity and a very long finish. Great with coffee and fine chocolates.
